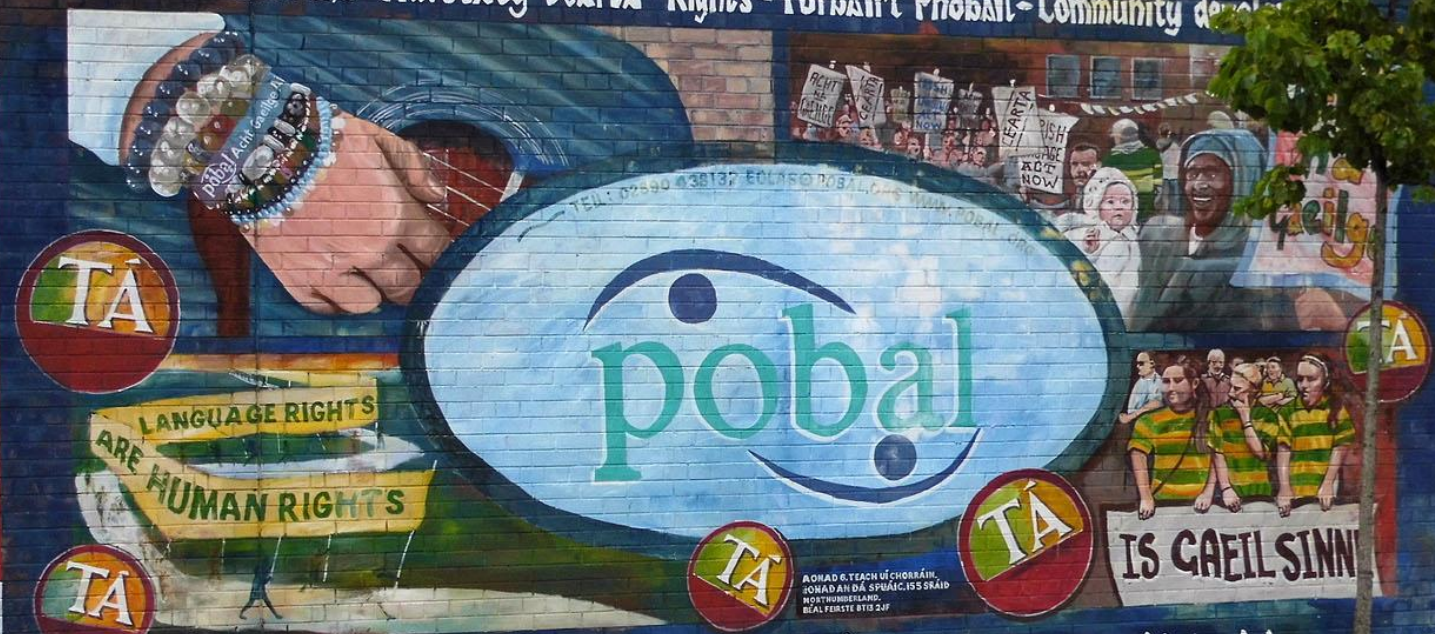

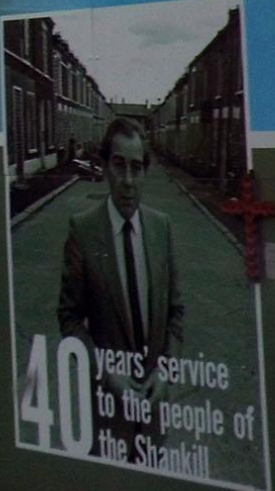

BELFAST CATHEDRAL

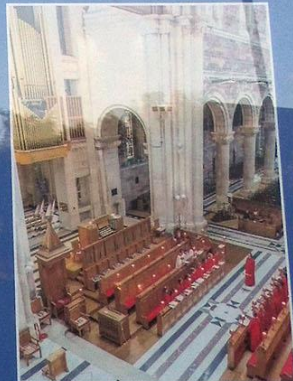
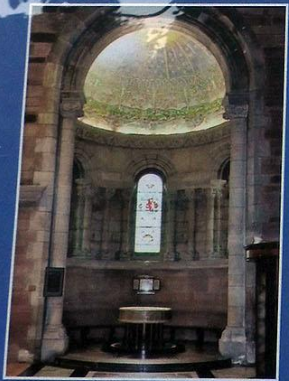

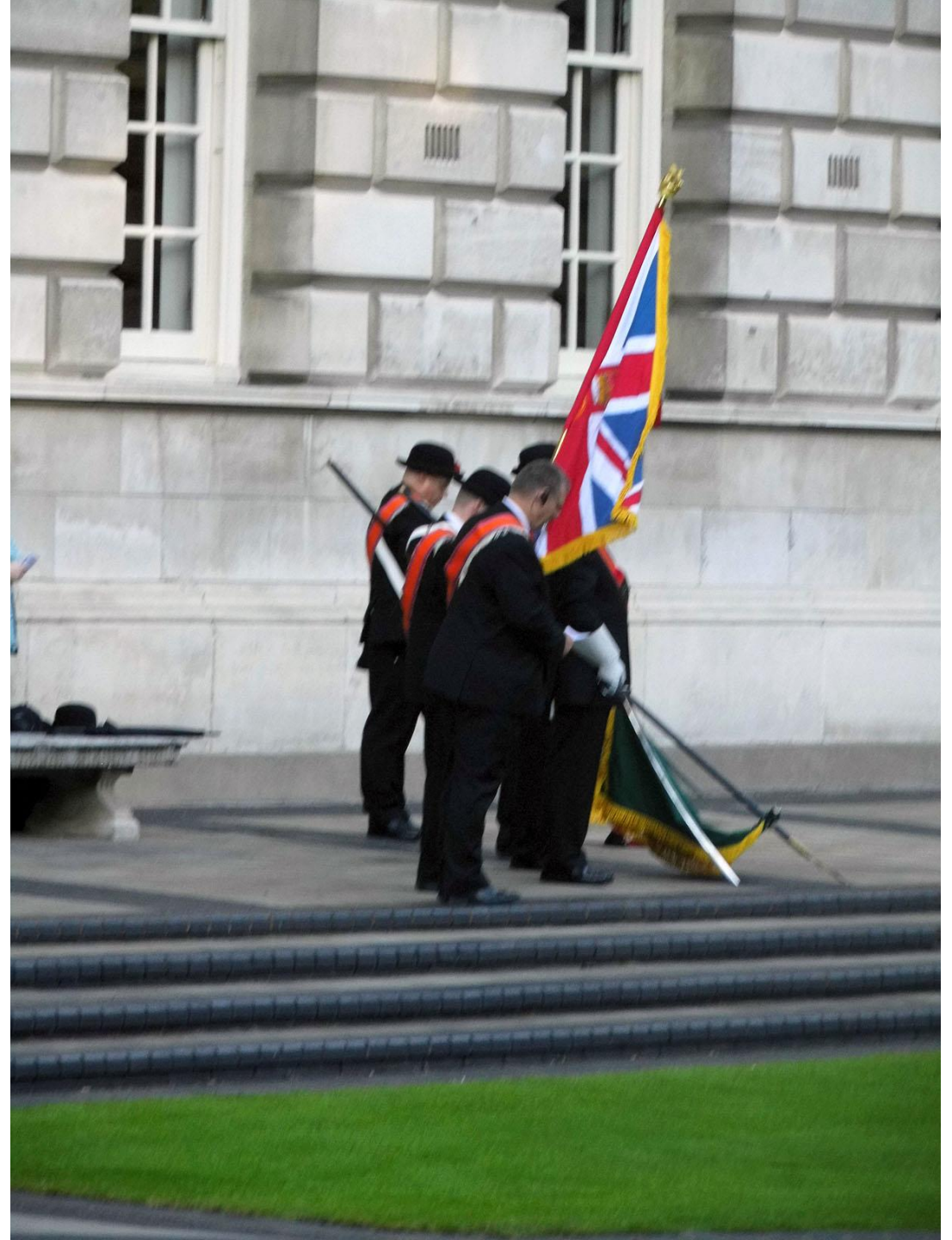
Please ask at our Welcome Desk for more information. All funds raised help us maintain this beautiful place of sanctuary, prayer and worship.
