THE DORIS BROTHERS BRIDGE

This bridge is named in honour of the Doris brothers of Westport. Founders of *The Mayo News* in 1892, they campaigned for tenant rights and the freedom of Ireland.

William Doris (1860-1926) was the Irish Parliamentary Party M.P. for West Mayo (1910-1918). He was imprisoned in 1881 for his Land League activities.

Patrick J. Doris (1866-1937) was the editor of *The Mayo News*. He was interned after the Easter Rising 1916 for his political activities.

MURRISK MILLENNIUM PARK

MURRISK MILLENNIUM PARK HAS BEEN DEVELOPED AS AN AREA OF PEACE, REFLECTION AND REST

■ EAST & WEST BOUNDRY

The East and West boundry planting consists of *Alnus Glutinosa*, *Crataegus Monogyna* and *Brtula Pubescens*.

■ SEMI-MATURE TREES

Acer Campesire, *Fraxinus Excelsior*, *malus Hupehensis* (John Downie), *Prunus Avium*.

■ SEATING AREAS

The two semi-circle seating areas constructed in limestone are complimentary in design with the Famine Memorial seating plinth.

■ OTHER WORKS

Other works included perimeter wall upgrading and periphery lighting.

■ LANDSCAPING

The landscaping of the park is designed to be unobtrusive allowing clear views of Croagh Patrick, The National Famine Memorial, Murrisk Abbey and Clew Bay.

■ SPRING POND

To conserve this existing natural feature, the pond was dredged and cleaned, its banks were strengthened and its surround was planted with *Caltha Palustris*, *Iris Pseudoacorus* and *Iris Setosa*.

■ PATHWAYS

Pathways linking all areas are of Fibreturf Grass Reinforcement.

■ SPIRITUAL REFLECTION

The Park also reflects the spiritual and aesthetic nature of Croagh Patrick which has been a place of pilgrimage for over 1500 years.

■ ACCESS BRIDGE

A new access bridge was constructed for vehicular, pedestrian and wheelchair use.

■ MARGINAL PLANTING

Butomus Umbellatus, *Iris Pseudoacorus*, *Myosotis Palustris*, *Sparganium Romosum*, *Thelypteris Palustris*, *Typha Mimima*.
